SCHOLARSHIPS TO PHD STUDENTS

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

- To be registered to the Doctoral Programs at IZU,
- Being at the Research Centers in IZU within the specified time and allocating time
- To have met the requirements of GPA, Language proficiency, ALES. (for domestic students)
- International and domestic Istanbul Sabahattin Zaim University PhD students will be able to apply.
- Care will be taken to ensure that the students to be awarded scholarships do not have any other occupations.

CONTINUATION CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP

- Having a GPA of 3.5 out of 4 in doctoral courses,
- To be successful in the first proficiency exam (unless there is a reasonable excuse) and in the thesis monitoring exams (to get a score of 75 and above),
- Sense of mission (duly fulfilling the duties assigned by the unit, being in the unit during duty hours, etc.).

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT, NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND DURATION

- Tuition fee and Dormitory (for unmarried students) facility to be provided by Istanbul Sabahattin Zaim University (IZU)
- Scholarships will be given to **10 doctoral students**, five from science and five from social sciences.
- Scholarships will be given by the **İlim Yayma Vakfi**.
- Program: **All Doctoral Programs**
- Scholarship amount: **2.500 – 3.000 TL**
- Duration: **4 years**

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Selection criteria for local students: 25% Science Exam, 25% Interview, 30% GPA, 10% language, 10% ALES
- Selection Criteria for International Students: 35% Science Exam, 35% GPA, + 30% Interview
- The selection of the scholarship holders will be made by the commission to be formed by IZU and İlim Yayma Vakfi.

APPLICATION:

Candidates who want to apply should send their master's transcript, language certificate, ALES certificate, and SSI document showing that they do not work in a workplace and send them to the e-mail address doktorabursu@izu.edu.tr until the end of the working day on **October 31, 2021**.
